# **Our Chair and Chief Executive's Statement**

"We are working to improve the life chances of people in the community who are economically, socially and health- deprived by working in partnership with relevant service providers"

The cost-of-living crisis is still impacting on our residents. It has been challenging for most of our residents to keep up with the household budget, paying bills, purchasing essential food and other necessities. Our staff have been busy supporting them, giving advice and helping with applications for whatever benefits and support they could qualify for from the government and other support agencies.

Similarly, BHA's property maintenance and other administrative costs have increased significantly due to the sharp increase in material, labour and borrowing costs.

Despite these challenges, we are delighted that our dedicated and hard-working staff have managed to successfully deliver all essential housing management services, meeting our key performance targets including the collection of rent. Our finances are in good shape. After paying for our ongoing costs and meeting our lenders' requirements our surplus for the year increased notably compared to the previous year.

Our involvement in a major 3-year research project 'Amar Bari, Amar Jibon' led by The Open University focussing on the entrenched housing and health inequalities of Bangladeshi elders in East London is being showcased at events by the project funders, Dunhill Medical Trust as an exemplary co-produced research project involving the community at every level of the research journey.

Our support for the community with healthy living by raising awareness, prevention and management of some of the most prevalent but preventable illnesses in the community like diabetes and cancer is acknowledged by the NHS. BHA is the anchor and fund holder for the London Bangladeshi Health Partnership (LBHP).

In this report you will be able to read about our work on the above projects and other activities during the year. We are grateful to our Board colleagues, and the staff team for their passionate and hard work over the year and especially during this challenging time.

We are obliged to our RP and Local Authority partners as well as all the statutory and voluntary agencies for their continued support with our work.


# আমাদের সভাপতি এবং প্রধান নির্বাহীর বিবৃতি





# **Hand Back**

We handed back a block of 15 flats in Dalston Lane, Hackney to the owners of this building, Metropolitan Thames Valley Housing (MTVH) on 31/07/2023. We have been managing these properties since they were built in 2008. We have done this by mutual agreement as they were no longer cost effective for us to continue to manage them.

# **OUR INVESTMENTS IN OUR STOCK**

#### **New installations**

During the year 2023/24, Bangla renewed 2 kitchens, 8 boilers and 1 bathroom spending £36,200. We spent £12,780 on cyclical work.

#### **Fire Safety**

During the year we complied with fire safety regulations. We communicated with all our residents to reassure them that their buildings are safe and advised them about their responsibilities to keep all communal areas and their homes safe from any fire risks. All gas checks are up to date and any works as recommended following our annual Fire Risk Assessments were carried out promptly. We spent £62,000 on Fire safety works.

#### **Decarbonisation Work**

BHA is committed to reducing carbon emissions across its properties. In line with national requirements, all social landlords must ensure their properties achieve an EPC rating of C or above by 2030.

Currently, BHA owns 17 properties that require upgrades to meet this standard. To support this, Bangla joined a consortium bid led by ISHA, securing 50% government funding toward the cost of the necessary work.

While this bid was successful, BHA will still need to contribute approximately £200K from its own funds to complete the project by March 2025.

All necessary surveys and work specifications have been prepared, tenders invited, and a contractor selected. The work is expected to be completed by September 2024.

# **Cost of Living Crisis**

#### Free healthy and fresh food

Working in partnership with Felix project and Morningside Community Centre we referred our residents who were struggling with their finances to obtain fresh fruit, vegetables and groceries.

### **Hackney Money Hub**

We signposted and helped to complete application forms for our residents applying for financial and benefits support through the Hackney Money Hub.

#### Health and wellbeing

We have been supporting our residents throughout the year by raising awareness about some of the serious preventable life-threatening illnesses. By actively participating with the Hackney and City Community Health Champion Forum we have been sharing and signposting information and services available to our residents. Some of these are on High Blood Pressure/ Type 2 Diabetes/ cancer screening/immunisation/ exercise/ improving mental health

#### **Smoking Cessation**

We supported the Smokefree Hackney campaign to assist those who would like to give up smoking and need help. We signposted residents to the City & Hackney stop smoking service as they offer 12 weeks support to help you quit, with your own dedicated stop smoking advisor and easy access to stop smoking medication.

# **OUR HEALTH PROJECTS**

# **Hackney Community Health Champion Forum (CHC)**

BHA is an active member of the Hackney Community Health Champions Forum. By attending the monthly Forum meetings, we have given our feedback and gathered the health information and resources including vaccinations, diabetes, and other long-term conditions. We then shared this information with our residents and the community including signposting to relevant service providers and resources improving access to the health services for our residents and the community.



## London Bangladeshi Health Partnership (LBHP)

BHA is the anchor organisation in this multiagency Health partnership project. LBHP brings together interdisciplinary group of key health partners with



Bangladeshi community organisations and representatives to support the development of a strategic workplan, aiming to respond to the health priorities of Bangladeshi communities in London and mitigate against health inequity.

LBHP was launched on 16/08/2023 with over 100 webinar guests marking South Asian Heritage Month 'Reflecting on Bangladeshi history and recognising the contribution of the British Bangladeshi diaspora to London and the NHS.'

Amongst the prominent quests speakers were Dr Somen Banerjee Director of Public Health, LBTH, HE Saida Muna Tasneem, High Commissioner of Bangladesh to UK and Ireland, Dr Nikita Kanani, Director of Clinical Integration, NHS England & Deputy SRO, NHS COVID-19 Vaccination. Dr Leonora Weil, Director, NHS London Legacy and Health Equity Partnership (LHEP), & Public Health Consultant, UKHSA London. Minara Chowdhury, Senior Director, Institute for Healthcare Improvement.

LBHP received funding from the NHS to organise and deliver a London Bangladeshi Health Inequalities Summit in September 2024 employing a part time Health Coordinator. BHA will be the grant holder and the employer for the Health Coordinator.

# **OUR COMMUNITY RESEARCH PROJECT**

# Amar bari, amar jibon' (My home, my life): developing living environments for Bangladeshi elders

Bangla Housing Association (BHA) is involved in a groundbreaking research project, focussing on the entrenched housing and health inequalities of Bangladeshi elders ('probin' in Bangla) in East London. This 3-year research project is funded by Dunhill Medical Trust (DMT) and led by The Open University (OU) in partnership with BHA and the Housing LIN (Learning and Information Network) and involving local Bangladeshi communities and practitioners exploring diversity and inclusion in later life living environments and communities. This project is the first in-depth research of its kind in the UK. It will benefit East London communities through:

- Developing more empowered local communities.
- Helping to create skilled and competent community researchers.
- Hearing the voices of local people.
- Providing a detailed understanding of current and future housing needs of Bangladeshi probin.
- Contributing to informing debates on housing and support, and how local housing strategies and investment plans can better address housing for later life.

We're interviewing 80 Probins (elders in Bangla) aged 50+ and 10 mutigenerational families from Hackney, Tower Hamlets, Newham and Redbridge using multi-lingual coresearch recruited from the community. The information will be analysed with support from the Bangla Research Advisory Group who are recruited from the community and the Professional Advisory Group comprising of local service providers, practitioners and policy makers to advise on local and national issues relevant to the research and to comment on findings. The findings from the research will inform local authorities, the government and policy makers with hard facts about the housing and health needs and aspirations of the Bangladeshi Probins living in East London.




